

Sec. 66-91. Removal of obstructions.

In case any person who shall have caused the same shall neglect or refuse to remove any obstruction, encumbrance, encroachment, merchandise, snow, ice, rubbish, solid waste, oil or other material or liquid regulated by sections 66-87 through 66-90 from the streets or walks in front of the lot owned or occupied by him, or from the alley adjacent thereto, after having been notified so to do at the direction of the chief of police or other authorized officer, the city may, if it shall deem it for the public interest, cause the same to be removed at once, and such obstruction shall be deemed an encroachment subject to the provisions of section 66-26.
